



Bouboulou Gold Concession

A NEAR SURFACE, ADVANCED-STAGE EXPLORATION TARGET
LOCATED IN BURKINA FASO, WEST AFRICA

- The Bouboulou exploration permit covers an area of 38.8 square kilometers in Burkina Faso.
- Burkina Faso is the 4th largest gold producer in Africa.
- Gold mineralization was first identified on the Bouboulou area by Boliden in 1997 where a Regional Rotary Air Blast drilling program outlined a broad north-east trending gold anomaly measuring 13km by 2 km over what is now the Bouboulou permit. The concession was then explored by Riverstone Resources and Roxgold Inc (TSX.V: ROG).
- Highlights of surface exploration programs include; surface rock sampling and trenching returning gold grades from 1.09 to 19.16 g/t gold. Four zones of gold mineralization have been identified on the property termed Koala, Rawema, Bouboulou 2 and Pelgtanga.
- Roxgold later completed reverse circulation (RC) and diamond drilling (DD) to test the four mineralized zones.

Summary & Work Program

- These results verify that zones of potentially economic gold mineralization exist on the property. The goal of the 2016 exploration program is to establish continuity of these zones and to extend them.
- The initial program will consist of 2000 meters of diamond drilling to a maximum depth of 200 meters.
- Nexus Gold Director, Warren Robb, P.Geo, was Chief Geologist for Roxgold in 2012, where he wrote the 43-101 on the property. Mr. Robb will plan and implement the Nexus Gold drill program at Bouboulou.
